To require the Federal Aviation Administration to establish minimum standards for space for passengers on passenger aircraft.

- 5 (a) Moratorium on Reductions to Aircraft
- 6 SEAT SIZE.—Not later than 30 days after the date of the
- 7 enactment of this Act, the Administrator of the Federal

- 9 reducing the size, width, padding, or pitch of seats on pas-

- 3 (b) Regulations Relating to Space for Pas-

- 1 (d) AIR CARRIER DEFINED.—In this section, the
- 2 term "air carrier" means an air carrier (as defined in sec-
- 3 tion 40102 of title 49, United States Code) that trans-
- 4 ports passengers by aircraft as a common carrier for com-
- 5 pensation.
