

CENSUS FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

Q: When is the deadline to respond to the 2020 U.S. Census?

A: In light of the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, the Census Bureau is extending the self-response and non-response follow up periods to September 30, 2020.

Q: How can I safely participate in the Census during the pandemic?

Q: How will I receive an invitation if I have a PO box?

A: The Census Bureau's Update Leave Operation sends census workers to drop off invitations at households that do not have mailboxes, including households that have PO boxes. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, this operation was originally delayed, but began in Hawaii on June 1, 2020.
